Plans call for drag racing, parts swap and chili bash at Milan Dragway on Saturday. The drag strip will open early for us to run our own eliminations, and later in the day, we can participate in the regular program. Then, after the strip closes, we will have our chili bash picnic dinner. John and Dianne Guyer will be preparing Carroll's own recipe, naturally. Of course, Detroit parts king Roger Hodyka will be there, along with Mike Chanter, John Vermeeresh and Mike Reimenshneider, all with unbelievable deals on hi-performance Ford parts.

Sunday will see over 200 cars in the north parking lot of Ford Motor Company's World Headquarters building. Trophies for the car show will be presented at the banquet at Doug's Body Shop in Ferndale.
