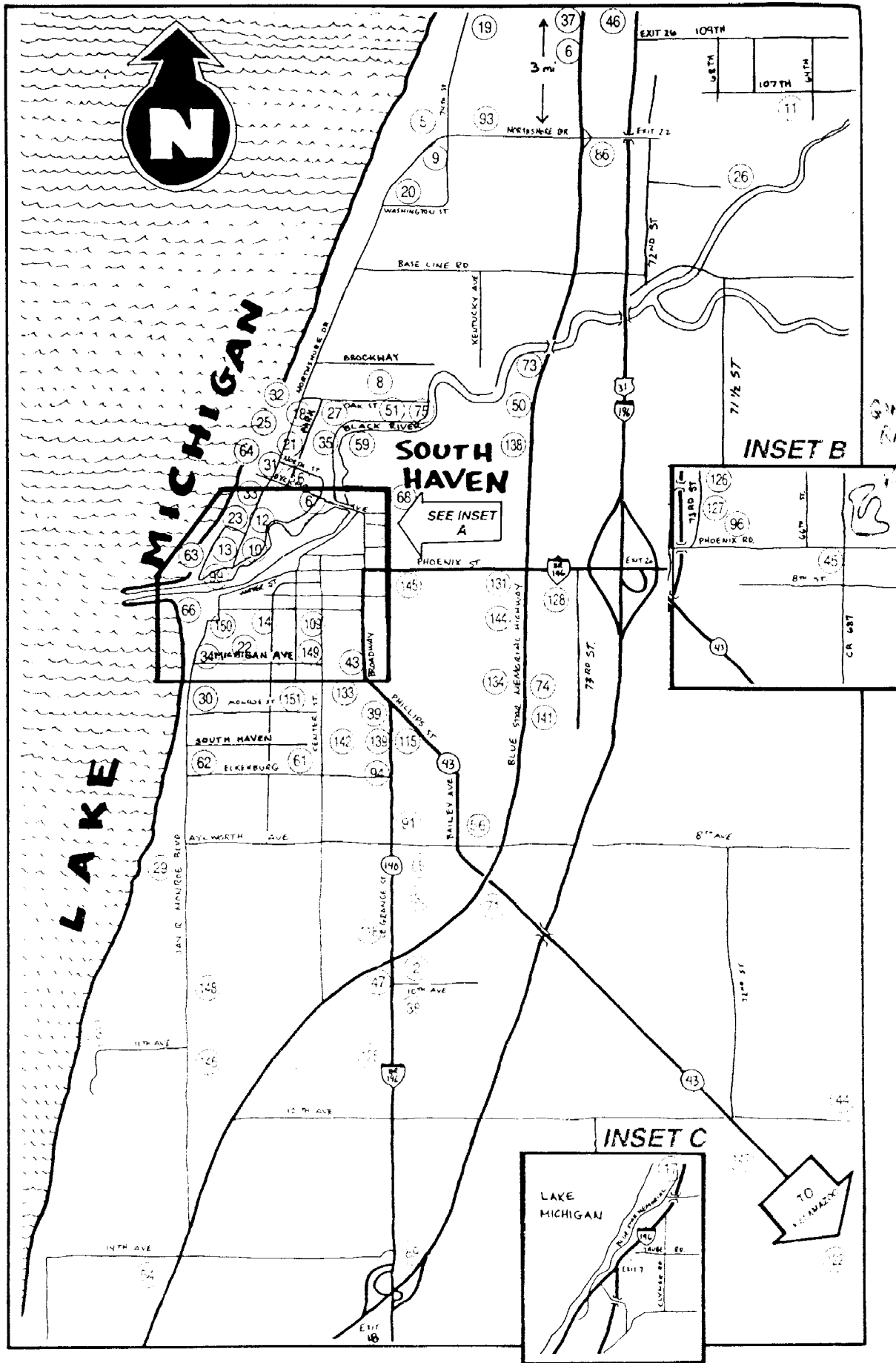

CHILI CHALLENGE

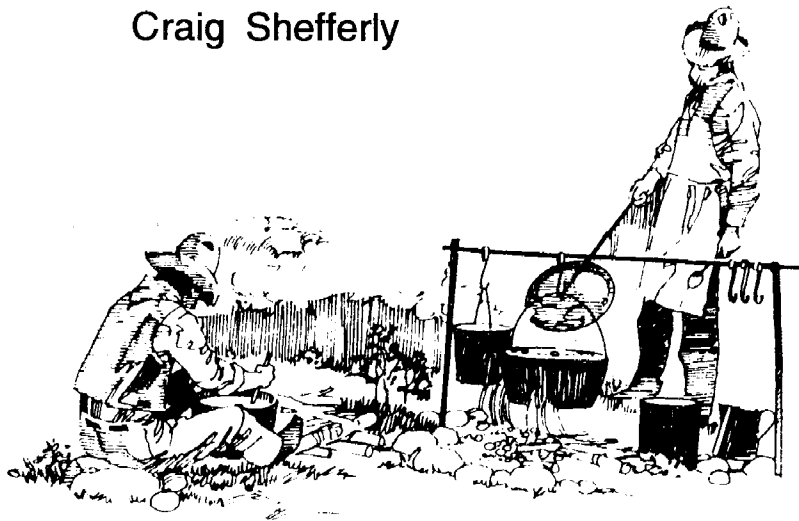

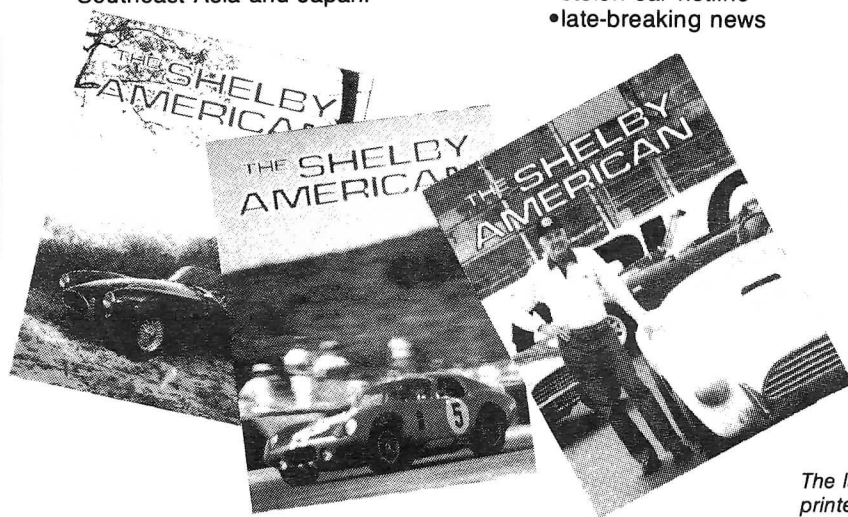

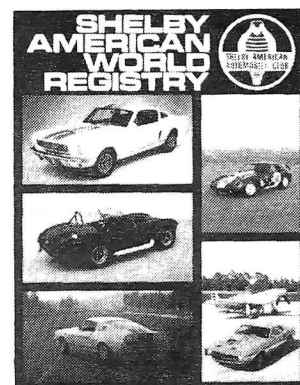

US POST OFFICE COMMEMORATES THE COBRA

U.S. postal commemorative cancellations are commonly used to celebrate special dates or events. A unique envelope or postcard is designed and printed, and a special postmark cancellation is created by the post office (with input from the individual or group undertaking the project). The pieces are given stamps and then cancelled on a particular date, using this unique cancellation. SAAC's Shelby Doc, Frank Zizzo, came up with the idea of creating a commemorative for SAAC-20 which would celebrate Shelby American's 1965 FIA World Manufacturers Championship. It was a natural - the date was July 4th, thirty years to the day that Shelby American clinched the title. The Shelby Doc asked Peter Brock to assist in coming up with the design of the cancellation. Brock's idea was simplicity in itself - the original Cobra logo which he had designed in 1961. Zizzo then asked SAAC to come up with several envelope designs and he chose the one he thought best reflected Shelby American: a Tom Honegger illustration of a Daytona Coupe, the venerable "CS" logo and Shelby American's 1601 West Imperial Highway address. Then Zizzo put a cherry on top. He got the envelopes cancelled on July 4th, 1995..... at the same post office Shelby American originally used - zip code 90009. Zizzo brought them to the convention in Atlanta where they proved to be one of the more popular items at SAAC Registration. They were priced at only \$10 each, with all of the proceeds going to the Shelby Heart Fund. We didn't find homes for them all. If you weren't in Atlanta (or if you were but missed them) here's your chance. To get one (or more) all you have to do is send a check for \$10 for each one you'd like, made out to the "Shelby Heart Fund." Send the check to SAAC HQ and we'll respond immediately. We don't expect the amount we have left to last very long.

The Shelby Encyclopedia

You could probably title this book "Everything You Ever Wanted To Know About Cobras And Shelybs... And Then Some." The *Shelby American World Registry* is the single most detailed source of information on these cars in the entire world. For the past four years a team of dedicated enthusiasts, all members of the Shelby American Automobile Club have been hard at work collecting information on every car Carroll Shelby touched between 1961 and 1970. It is a daunting undertaking because there were a total of 1003 Cobras built and 13,769 Shelby Mustangs. Information came from owners, enthusiasts and Shelby factory records. It concerns virtually every aspect of these cars from how they were originally delivered (and when, and to what dealer), to individual histories (who owned them, when, and what if anything was done to them), to race history (where they raced, under what number, who drove them and how they finished).

All of this information has been gathered, collated and put into a computer program designed especially for this function. Not only does SAAC have a huge database containing all manners of information on these cars but it will soon be outputted as a 1000-page book which has all of the information neatly catalogued and separated by sections on each type and year of car.

Owners are always eager to learn how their car was special, and because Shelby's cars were built in such small numbers, and in so many variations, almost every car is somehow unique. This uniqueness is partly responsible for the high level of interest in these cars today.

One of the most interesting aspects are the individual histories. Each car has a story and although not every Cobra or Shelby passed through the hands of a celebrity owner, the number that have is surprising. For example, Steve McQueen had a Cobra. And so did comedians Tom Smothers. Bill Cosby and Mort Sahl. Television broadcaster Dave Garroway had one and so did pro golfer Ken Venturi and band leader Ray Conniff. Astronaut Scott Carpenter had one and so did singer Jimmy Webb. Baseball pitcher Don Drysdale was a Cobra owner, and so were actors Paul Petersen. Barry Bostwick and Michael Nouri. Sylvester Stallone owned two for a brief period of time. His Majesty the King of Sweden owns an early Shelby GT350. So does Tonight host Jay Leno. Buster Crabbe, Jackie Cooper and Lee Marvin owned later models. So did Sean Penn and Kevin Costner. And believe it or not, Elizabeth Taylor even owned a black and gold GT350 Hertz briefly. Although Elvis Presley never owned a Cobra he drove one in the movie "Spinout." And Anne Francis drove one in her television series "Honey West."

This is the third edition of the *Shelby American World Registry* published by SAAC. Each one has contained an increasingly larger amount of information than the last one. If you're interested in getting a copy drop a note to SAAC, PO Box 788, Sharon, CT 06069 and they'll tell you how.

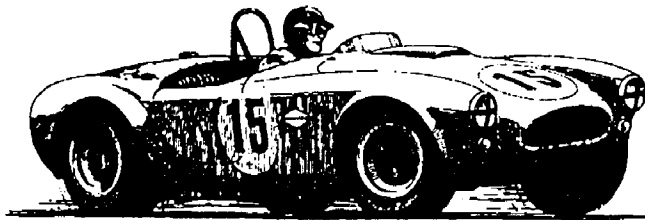

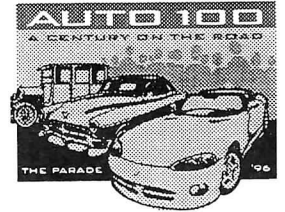

Please submit your completed application with a photo of your entry and a check or money order no later than April 30, 1996 payable to the Michigan State Fair.

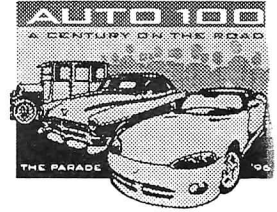

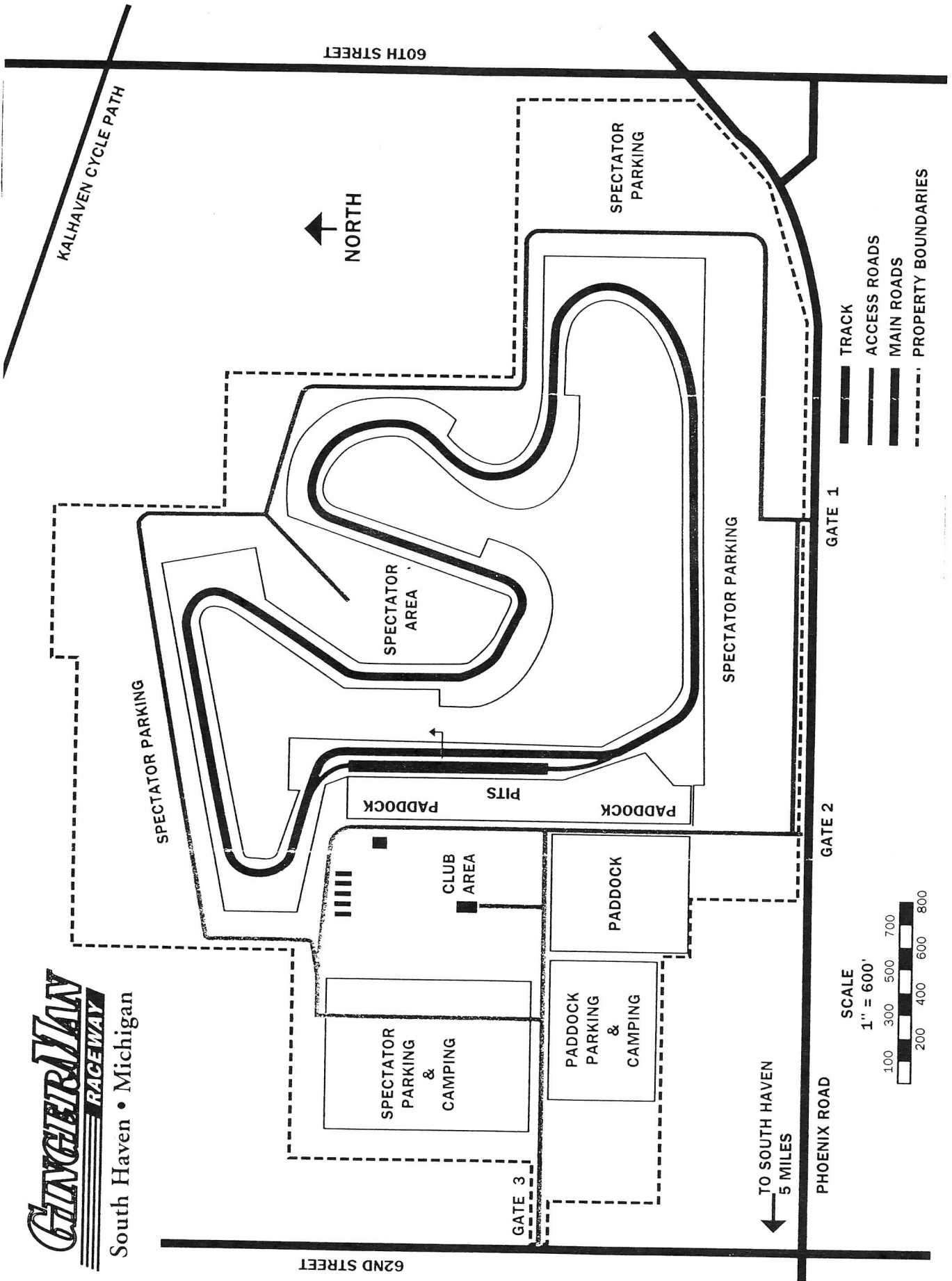

HOT LAPS AT GINGER MAN

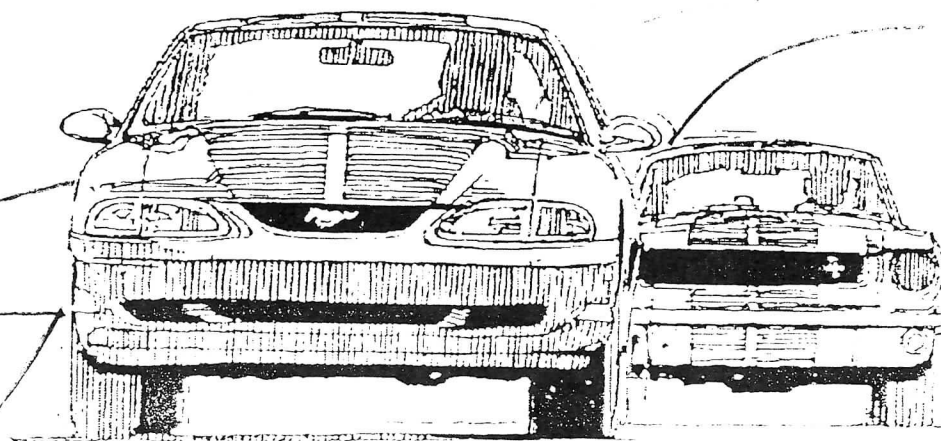

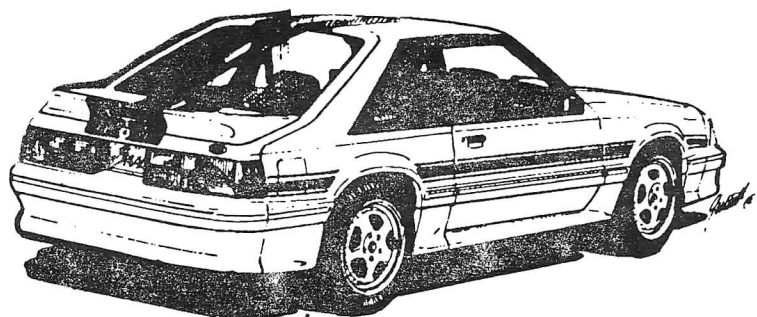

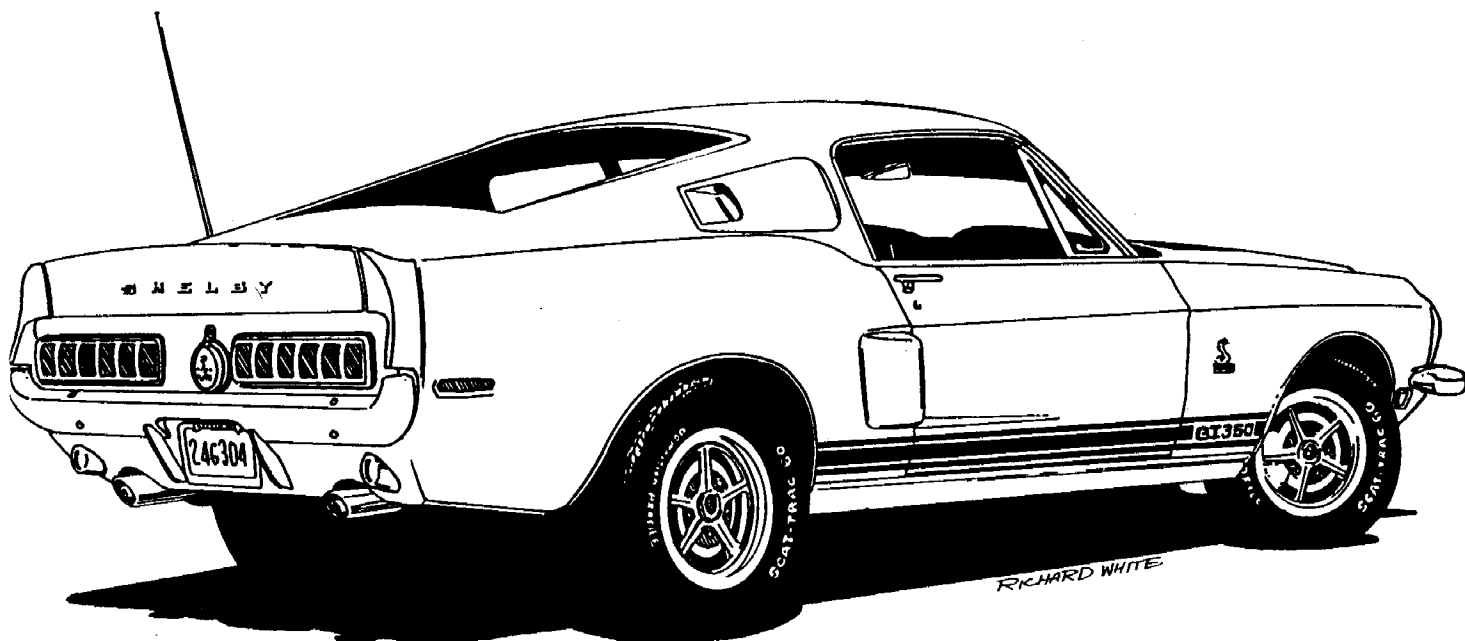
