CONVENTION NEWS IN BRIEF SINCE THE LAST SNAKEBITE

Convention schedule remains unchanged. ● Open Track spots already 1/3 filled. ● Ford SVT presence likely
Carroll Shelby planning to attend ● Garages all taken - don't even think about a waiting list.

CONVENTION PRE-REGISTRATION

The form to use is printed below. The \$150.00 per-person fee covers all 3 days and includes everything.

CONVENTION WALK-IN REGISTRATION

If you are not able to attend for all 3 days, or do not want everything that is included in the 3-day package, you can register when you arrive at the track and pay by the day. In-person registration will be \$25 per person/per day. T-shirts, hats, dinner tickets and dash plaques will be available as long as supplies last.

OPEN TRACK

Michigan Speedway is one of the fastest tracks in the country. NASCAR and CART both hold events here that are among the most prestigious races on their calendars. And as a rule, they do not rent the track out to clubs. Obviously, SAAC is the exception. We'll be using a combination of the banked oval and road course (1.9 miles). If you want to run Michigan Speedway but prefer to wait to register for the convention when you arrive, we suggest that you pre-register for the open track to avoid disappointment because both days are likely to be filled well before June. Use the form below.

CONVENTION HOTELS.

We've secured blocks of rooms at several hotels in Ann Arbor/Ypsilanti area, about 35 miles from the track. All hotels in this area typically are at 100% occupancy during June, and our blocks of rooms will not last indefinitely, so we strongly suggest that you reserve your room early. Each of the convention hotels listed below will have additional security during the SAAC-24 weekend. When you make your reservation, tell them you are attending the SAAC convention.

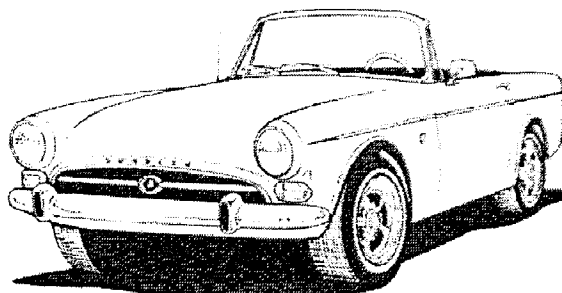

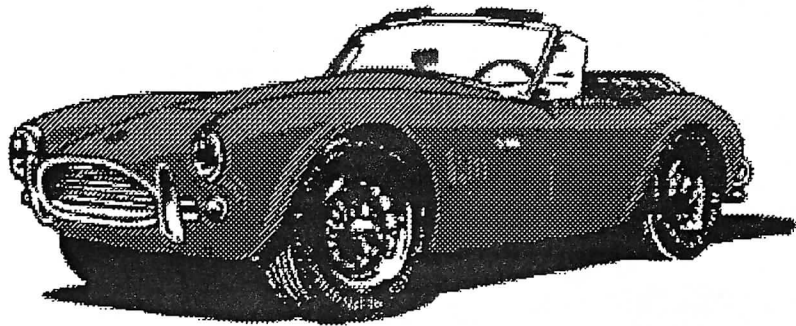

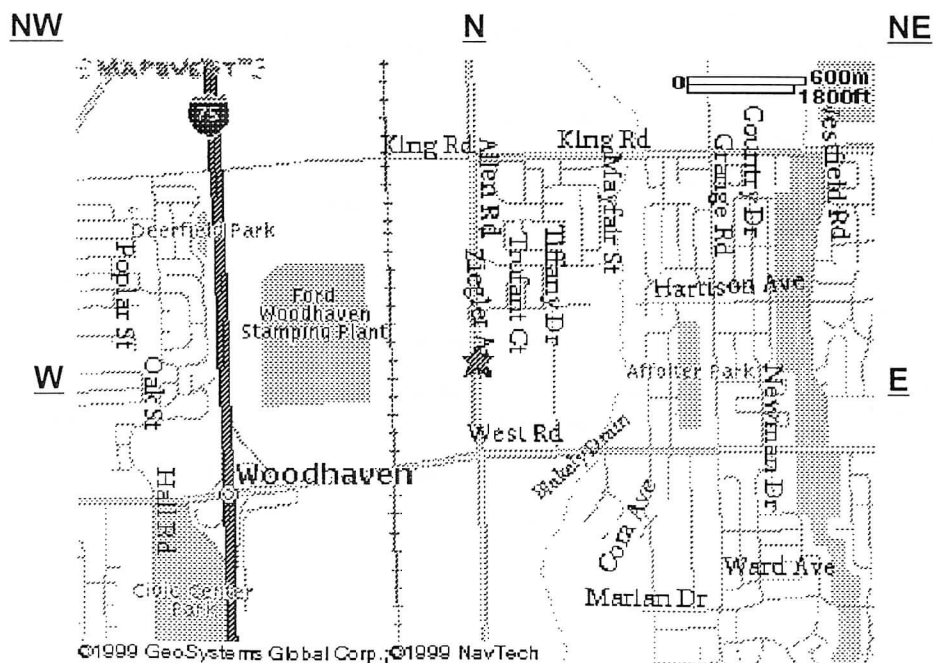
